 This romantic port just outside St. Austell was built in 1791 to handle ore from the mines, but was soon replaced by China-Clay. Now-a-days it has become a home to the Square Rigger and is used a lot in period dramas, including recently for scenes from the popular series Poldark. There are beautiful woodlands nearby, a shipwreck, rescue and heritage centre, and independent shops and quality pubs as well as restaurants. All situated in this quaint Old-World time warp.
